Proposals aimed for the Land Reform Conference.

- 1. Recovering of Neuenhoff area to Swartrand communal farmers alienated in 1968 by the former colonial regime.
- 2. Make loans available to commercial farmers in communal areas to relieve pressure on the concerned areas.
- 3. The Government is also being urged to make loans available to small farmers for supplementing their stocks.
- 4. Appointment of agricultural experts in communal areas for soil valuation to point out which kind of farming should be applied in the particular area.
- 5. Establishing of centres for ageds in communal areas with necessary infra-structures to create small industries like gardening, needle-work, skin articles - except the legendary bottle stores. The ageds will earn additional income from such industries.
- 6. The Government is also being urged to construct two bridges in Löwer- and Mudubriver in Uibes communal area for eliminating communication problems during the rainseasons.
- 7. *The Farmers occupying more than two Farms, should only be paid for the Infra-structure.*
