## CHRONOLOGY CHRONOLOGIE

- 19.12.1913 born in Berlin
- 1931-1933 studied art at the "Vereinigte Staatsschulen für Freie und Angewandte Kunst"/Berlin
- 1933 Kunstakademie München  
Journey by cargo-boat to Siberia
- 1934 Military training in Berlin
- 1934-1939 studied at "Preussische Staatsakademie für Bildende Künste in Berlin/Charlottenburg
- 1935 Master student of the above
- 1939 With the German army in Poland and France
- 1941 North Africa with Rommel's "Afrika Korps"
- 1942 Taken prisoner at Tobruk/prisoner-of-war camps in Egypt, Palestine and Victoria/Australia, always applying his art
- 1947 released and sent back to Germany
- 1947-1950 living in Berlin, illustrations "Moby Dick", "Peer Gynt", "Wal-Fontänen", "Reineke Fuchs"
- 1951 emigrated to South Africa/Cape Town
- 1951 arrived in SWA, headquarters Windhoek, travelling throughout the territory, later to Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Europe
- 1966 travelling through Minor Asia, Middle East, Iran, Pakistan to India
- 28.7.1966 killed by an elephant near the mouth of the Ootacan River, buried there.
